STUDENT ENGAGEMENT & TRAINING



- PharmAlliance Research Clusters for Doctoral Training (PARCDT) supported 10+ PhD students across institutions, facilitating scientific collaborations and global partnerships.
- Exchange program supported training of 200+ pharmacy students in research and practice.

ADVOCACY FOR PRACTICE



- “Communication Tools & Tactics” seminars featured experts who shared strategies to translate research into practice and education including topics about infographics, podcasts, press releases, amplifying the patient voice, and reaching policymakers.
- Pharmacy society leaders were engaged around the globe as speakers and attendees at annual conferences.

COLLABORATION IN EDUCATION

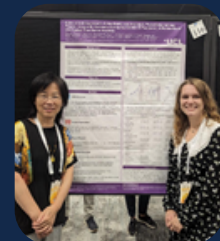


- Cultural competency modules were co-created and accessed by 5,900+ learners globally.
- New MyDispense simulations were collaboratively designed introducing Electronic Health Records (EHR) and independent prescribing.
- AI avatars were co-designed to teach students communication skills in culturally diverse settings.
- An open-access vaccine champion curriculum was co-developed, delivered, and shared at a national conference and implemented in five countries.

RETURN ON INVESTMENT



- Extramural funding of \$7M+ USD was received resulting in over 3x financial return.
- PARCDT funding, Early Career Researcher Awards, and internal seed funding yielded 44 publications, 40 presentations, and 3 awards.
